Vaccine Booster

We continue to talk with Walgreens to schedule a date for a COVID-19 vaccine booster clinic. If you are taking your loved one off campus to get them vaccinated, or if you plan to receive the Covid Booster on your own, you will need to take their original vaccine card.

- **Families:** Please notify the Charge Nurse for your loved one's neighborhood that your family member is getting the booster shot because our team needs to monitor the residents after their vaccine for any side effects. Please do not take them without letting us know! We will also need the vaccination card returned when the resident comes back to campus. Thank you for helping us keep your loved ones safe and our records up-to-date.
- **Residents:** After you receive your Booster vaccine, please visit the Paulsen Clinic and have Lenee or Tracy make a copy of your vaccination card for our files.
