All team member COVID-19 test results for this week are negative. Our care areas - Assisted Living, Healthcare and the Rehabilitation Center - are open to visitors. Visitation guidelines for healthcare facilities, like Westminster Canterbury, must meet a higher standard as we follow federal regulations from the Center for Medicare/Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

While other areas of our society and community have relaxed requirements related to wearing masks and social distancing, we are not permitted to do so at this time. We must continue to protect our residents - your loved ones - and our team members. This means that our guidelines for visiting have not changed. Please help us by adhering to the following:

Number of People: 2 visitors at one time may visit *in the resident's room only*. Visiting is not permitted in common areas such as lobbies, dining rooms and lounge areas.

Screening Required: Stop in the Main Lobby for temperature and travel screening. You will receive a visitor pass.

Face Masks and Social Distancing are Required.

Visiting Hours: 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
