I am pleased to report that the COVID-19 test results for all staff members and residents retested earlier this week are negative.


Visitation resumed today, May 6, 2021, for the 4th floor neighborhood of the Drinkard Healthcare Center. All areas of our campus are now open to visitors.

Visitor Guidelines

- We continue to have visits in the resident's rooms only-- no common areas. Outside visits are acceptable and encouraged.
- If the resident and visitors are FULLY vaccinated (2 weeks post 2nd dose), they may remove their masks while in the room with the visitors and can have close contact. They must replace their masks if a staff member walks in or as soon as they leave the room.
- **Visitors must present evidence of vaccination to our screening desk in the Main Lobby (under the Bridge) to receive the correct visitor's pass that will allow for this to occur. Proof of vaccination must be presented with each visit, either as a paper copy or a picture on your phone.**
- *Visitors who are NOT vaccinated must wear a face mask at ALL TIMES.* Once screened by the WC team, these visitors will receive a color-coded visitor pass in order to assist team members within our neighborhoods as we continue to monitor signs and symptoms for COVID-19 among our residents.
- Visitation will stop when any new, positive cases are identified. This is our current guideline.
- Residents on isolation precautions are not able to have visitors unless for compassionate care/end of life reasons.
- Number of visitors per resident = 2 people; family members, children or friends.
- Hours for visiting: 9 a.m. – 8 p.m.
