



## CAMPUS UPDATE – June 3, 2021

We are pleased to report that all team member COVID-19 test results for this week are negative. Our care areas - Assisted Living, Healthcare and the Rehabilitation Center - are open to visitors. Visitation guidelines for healthcare facilities as set by the Center for Medicare/Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) have not changed.

While Westminster Canterbury is able to relax requirements related to wearing masks and social distancing in certain sections of campus, we are not permitted to do so in care neighborhoods at this time. We must continue to protect our residents - your loved ones - and our team members. This means that our guidelines for visiting continue. Please help us by adhering to the following:

- **Number of People:** 2 visitors at one time may visit in the resident's room only. Visiting is not permitted in common areas such as lobbies, dining rooms and lounge areas.
- **Screening Required:** Stop in the Main Lobby for temperature and travel screening. You will receive a visitor pass.
- **Face Masks and Social Distancing are Required.**
- **Visiting Hours:** 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
