



CAMPUS UPDATE - 7/29/2021

We need to inform you of a recent positive COVID-19 test result for a member of our team. This individual is a part-time employee who last worked on July 16. The result of our investigation into this case revealed no exposure to residents or coworkers. Visitation remains open for our Healthcare, Assisted Living and Memory Support neighborhoods.

With the increase in COVID infections in the local area, as well as nationally, we continue to encourage and educate our team members on the importance of being vaccinated.

Mask Requirement

Due to the rise in the local positivity rate, All Visitors and WC team members - regardless of vaccination status - will need to wear masks within all areas of our campus. This includes independent living public spaces. The re-instatement of this guideline takes effect Friday, July 30, 2021.

Temperature screening for all visitors remains in place. Please come to the main lobby to be screened and to receive your visitor pass.

We recommend that unvaccinated residents and immune-compromised residents wear masks when in common indoor spaces on campus and certainly when inside public buildings off-campus. The CDC has recommended that fully vaccinated people begin wearing masks indoors again in places with high COVID-19 transmission rates. We will continue to monitor these local indicators and update our guidance over the coming weeks.

Hearthside Building Update

We are still working to resolve issues from our recent water leak on the 5th floor of the Hearthside building. One of the problems is the repair of that structure's main elevator. We are hopeful it will be back in service the week of August 2.

We apologize for the inconvenience this causes for family members and friends visiting loved ones. We are hopeful that most of the cleaning procedures will be complete by the end of the week.
