

CAMPUS UPDATE – July 7, 2021

Many restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic put in place by Virginia Gov. Ralph Northam have now been lifted. Discussions with our administrative leadership, residents and health professionals have helped us reach a place of cautious optimism for Westminster Canterbury.

Before I share what's changing, I want to remind you of what will remain in place.

1. Guests coming to campus still need to be screened in the Main Lobby.
2. The screening equipment, sign-in register and visitor badges will be positioned at the reception desk over the coming week. This procedure is still required in order to help our infection control team should a resident test positive for COVID-19 and we have to implement contact tracing for people who have visited that person.
3. Visitor Guidelines for our Drinkard Healthcare, Hearthside Assisted Living and Hearthside Rehab Center (6th floor) remain in place. CMS/Medicare has not changed its policies. Residents in these neighborhoods may have 2 visitors at a time, in their residence (no public areas) between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Temperature screening in our main lobby is required in order to receive a visitor badge.

Effective Friday, July 9, 2021

Changes for Independent Apartment and Cottage Residents

1. No restriction in the number of guests per residence (apartment or cottage).
2. Vaccinated guests do not have to wear a mask in common areas.
3. Vaccinated guests are welcome in all dining areas on the 3rd floor: Canterbury Café, James River Grille and the Dogwood Dining Room. Reservations are required for the Grille and the Dogwood. There are no limits on the number of guests for meals.
4. The Templeton Wellness Center and the pool are open to all participants, including Azalea Plan and Canterbury Club members.
5. All independent living activities and programs are open to full capacity.
6. Vaccinated clergy - - ministers, priests and rabbis - - are permitted to visit and to resume group luncheons with parishioners.


As a Reminder:

- Two Guest Rooms are open for reservations by residents only. Contact the front desk to secure the dates for your visitors.
- Overnight guests, vaccinated or not, are permitted in apartments and cottages.
- No limits on social gatherings. All meeting rooms are at full capacity.

We continue to monitor the status of COVID-19 cases in the Lynchburg area. If the positivity rate changes and starts to go up, we may need to resume some limitations. With your help and cooperation, we hope this isn't necessary.

Thank you again for your continued patience and understanding as we enter the summer months. We will remain vigilant in our efforts to safeguard all residents and all of our team members.
