



CAMPUS UPDATE – 9/27/2021

We want to inform you that we have identified a couple in Independent Living that have tested positive for COVID-19. These individuals will be in isolation protocol for 10 days. We have worked with our resident clinic team to identify and notify anyone who may have come in contact with them over the past few days.

Due to new COVID protocols from the CDC and local health department, the people who were in contact are not being quarantined but will be tested as a precaution. This recent infection does not appear to be linked to the infection of another independent living resident that we had last week.

We also have a staff member who tested positive on Sunday, September 26. This individual did not have any exposure to our residents.

Visitation remains open at this time across the entire campus.

As we have shared in our Confab broadcasts, the local health district numbers for COVID-19 cases are dangerously high. Please be careful when out in the community by wearing a mask when in public places and practicing social distancing. If you have a guest coming to campus, please ensure they wear a mask when they are inside our public spaces.
