

## CAMPUS UPDATE for Independent Living Areas - May 28, 2021


It's been great to see so many smiling faces around our campus now that mask and physical distancing requirements have been lifted for residents who are fully vaccinated. Individuals who are not fully vaccinated against the coronavirus are expected to wear a mask in indoor, public areas of campus.

As we enter the Memorial Day holiday weekend, Governor Ralph Northam has again lifted restrictions within Virginia. Here is our plan for moving forward with expanding group activities and, eventually, more guests.

1. Meeting rooms will return to previous occupancy levels without restrictions.
2. Studio Classes in the Wellness Center and classes held outdoors are now at 12 people. We are reviewing the Governor's guidelines to determine if this number can be increased.
3. We will maintain 8 people in the pool and 2 people in the spa for now.
4. **Dining venues are not open to guests at this time.** We will have an update related to this issue in the near future.
5. **Visitors to Cottages and Apartments must be screened in the main lobby. Visitors must still wear a mask in public spaces until you are inside a residence.** Visitors are not required to wear masks when outside. Screenings are critical in order to help our team perform contact tracing if new cases of COVID-19 were to be identified among residents.
6. Fully vaccinated travelers do not need to self-quarantine following domestic travel or international travel.
7. At this time, there are no positive test results for this week among our team members, and there are no changes to visitation in Healthcare, Assisted Living or Memory Support. Visitation with restrictions remain in place, including our mask policy.
