



CAMPUS UPDATE – January 12, 2021

We need to report there is one positive test result for a resident of our 6th floor Drinkard Healthcare Center. This individual had a negative test result on January 8. A second test on January 11 produced a positive result and the healthcare team transferred this person to our COVID-19 isolation unit earlier today. This resident was transported to the hospital this afternoon for further evaluation and treatment.

All residents of the Memory Support neighborhood were tested on Saturday, January 9 and there are no positive test results at this time.

There are no new positive test results for team members working in our Drinkard Healthcare or Memory Support neighborhoods at this time. Staff members were tested again today and will continue on the twice-weekly cycle because the positivity rate in the City of Lynchburg is now over 20 percent.

Visitation in all care areas, Assisted Living, Drinkard Healthcare, Memory Support and the 6th floor of Hearthside, remains suspended. Families are permitted to visit those residents receiving end of life care.

Visitation for all apartment and cottage residents is limited to outdoor spaces only. Family members are not permitted in our buildings.

Vaccination Day: January 13

Plans are in place for the team from Walgreens to administer the COVID-19 vaccine to all residents and staff members tomorrow, January 13. Please report at the time you've been assigned and be patient during this process. Our goal is to vaccinate everyone who wants to receive the shot. However, this is contingent on the number of doses Walgreens brings to our campus.
