We need to report we received a positive COVID-19 test result for one team member today. This person last worked the evening of January 10 on the 6th floor of Hearthside Assisted Living. The individual did not feel well the following day and sought medical care on their own. This individual followed proper infection control procedures while working and wore Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) properly as required.

Staff members will be tested tomorrow, January 14, as the twice-weekly cycle for COVID-19 continues.

Visitation in all care areas, Assisted Living, Drinkard Healthcare, Memory Support and the 6th floor of Hearthside, remains suspended. Families are permitted to visit those residents receiving end of life care.

Visitation for all apartment and cottage residents is limited to outdoor spaces only. Family members are not permitted in our buildings.

Congratulations on a successful Vaccination Day! We were very pleased to receive all the doses of the vaccine that we requested. Thank you for participating as we take the next step for enhancing the safety of our campus. Special thanks goes to all the team members and volunteers, under the direction of our lead nurses Ashley Jordan and Olena Mahne, who helped today go smoothly.

Be sure to keep your vaccination card in a safe place. You will need it again when the second dose of vaccine is administered on February 3.
