



CAMPUS UPDATE – January 21, 2021

We need to report that we have a resident in the Memory Support Area that has tested positive for COVID-19. The resident has been moved to the COVID isolation area on the 6th floor of the old Drinkard building. There are now four residents in isolation there and one resident who was admitted to the COVID unit at the hospital.

We also need to share that we received positive COVID-19 test results for two team members today. One individual works on the 6th floor of Drinkard Healthcare and the second team member works in the 4th floor Hearthsides Assisted Living neighborhood.

Both of these individuals followed proper infection control procedures while working and wore Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) properly as required. Their last day working on campus is January 19.

As reported during our weekly Confab broadcast earlier, all team members were tested again today as part of our twice weekly protocol. This is the 35th round of testing since July 2020. Residents of 6th floor Hearthsides Healthcare were also tested.

Visitation in all care areas, Assisted Living, Drinkard Healthcare, Memory Support and the 6th floor of Hearthsides, remains suspended. Families are permitted to visit those residents receiving end of life care.

Visitation for all apartment and cottage residents is limited to outdoor spaces only. Family members are not permitted in our buildings.
