



## **CAMPUS UPDATE – January 9, 2021**

We need to report that two residents of our Memory Support neighborhood tested positive for COVID-19 today. One resident exhibited mild symptoms, was tested for COVID-19 and assessed by our staff members.

All residents of the Memory Support neighborhood were tested again today and another resident had a positive result. After consultation with Dr. Lord, our medical director, and the residents' family members, the decision was made to move these individuals to the COVID-19 isolation unit on campus.

Team members caring for these residents are following all infection control protocols and guidelines to provide appropriate care. They wear full personal protective equipment at all times and are taking care of all their needs.

There are no positive test results for residents of our Drinkard Healthcare Center at this time. Testing for staff members will be conducted again on Tuesday, January 12.

Visitation in all care areas, Assisted Living, Drinkard Healthcare, Memory Support and the 6th floor of Hearthside, remains suspended until further notice. Families are permitted to visit those residents receiving end of life care.

Visitation for all apartment and cottage residents is limited to outdoor spaces only. Family members are not permitted in our buildings.
