



CAMPUS UPDATE - October 15, 2020

Westminster Canterbury of Lynchburg has identified three additional staff members who tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. These individuals work for our Senior Independence Home Health and Hospice agency **and did not have contact with any residents on the Westminster Canterbury campus.**

As we shared in our October 12 communication, one Senior Independence team member had contact with four residents in the Drinkard Health Center. All residents in healthcare were tested last week and all had negative results.

If there are no positive test results among the Drinkard residents and staff members who tested on October 14, family visitation to this part of campus may resume on Monday, October 26. Look for a new schedule from June McNamara.

Family visits for Assisted Living and Memory Support residents continue, as well as outdoor visits for Brookhaven, Creekside and Cottage residents' families. Procedures for these areas remain the same.

Please continue to wear facemasks, wash your hands often and practice social distancing in all public areas on and off campus. Thank you for your continued patience and understanding.
