Visitation resumes on Monday, November 16 for residents of the Drinkard Healthcare Center and the Rehab Center on 6th floor Hearthside. There were no positive test results among residents in the Drinkard Center after testing conducted on Nov. 2. The cycle of COVID-19 testing for staff members completed on Tuesday, Nov. 10 produced no positive results.
