



CAMPUS UPDATE – November 20, 2020

Our recent cycle of testing for staff members this week produced five new positives for COVID-19. Of these five individuals, one works in therapy, two in assisted living, one in environmental services, and the other on the 3rd floor of the Drinkard Healthcare Center.

Upon receiving the test results this morning, we performed antigen testing on these five staff members. Only one of the five tested positive again, so we are investigating if the initial results could have been false readings. Additional molecular/PCR tests were also conducted. We anticipate getting those results back on Monday.

All team members were sent home to quarantine immediately after the additional tests were done. We have notified residents and/or families that had contact with these individuals.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY – Visitation for Assisted Living and Memory Support residents has stopped and is discontinued until further notice. COVID-19 testing for these residents is underway.

We will update you as we learn more regarding this situation.

The Drinkard Healthcare Center and 6th Floor Hearthside Rehab remains closed to visitors due to the positive result for a team member on Nov. 18. All Drinkard residents have been tested for the virus and we await the results.

Please continue following our safety guidelines on campus:

1. Wear your facemask in all public spaces.
2. Only 2 people at one time in the elevator with masks on.
3. Practice social distancing with everyone you encounter, staying at least 6 feet apart.
4. Wash your hands often and disinfect frequently touched services regularly.

Our Environmental Services team continues daily disinfection of high touch surfaces in public areas; however, using hand sanitizer around elevators, doorways and upon entering the Café is still recommended.
