



CAMPUS UPDATE – November 23, 2020

The number of cases of COVID-19 continues to trend upward in our health district and the nation. We are seeing this trend with the number of infections in our staff members as well.

As a follow up to last weeks' notice, I am pleased to report that all residents in healthcare, assisted living and memory support tested **NEGATIVE** for COVID-19. We continue our protocols of monitoring daily for signs and symptoms.

While this is good news, we are still required to restrict visitation. Family visits in the healthcare, assisted living and memory support neighborhoods remain suspended until further notice.

The five staff members that identified as positive on Friday (Nov. 20) will remain out of work for a minimum of 10 days, per health department guidelines.

Unfortunately, there were 15 residents that had contact with a COVID infected staff member last Friday. These residents will quarantine for 14 days. Resident Life staff members are working with these residents and their spouses to take care of their needs. Per health department guidelines, we are not testing quarantined residents unless they are exhibiting signs and symptoms.

In addition to the five staff members identified on Friday, there are two more employees that tested positive for COVID over the weekend. One of the staff members works in Dining Services and the other works in Environmental Services. You will be notified if you came in close contact with either individual.

Service and Activities Changes:



2. Some larger group meetings are cancelled this week and may be cancelled again next week out of an abundance of caution. Church services may be cancelled as

3. If you use the Wellness Center Gym with someone else, wear a mask completely covering your face. If you are alone, you can remove it.
4. If you plan to leave campus for Thanksgiving, we ask that you be extra cautious. If you happen to be exposed to someone who was sick during a visit, please let our clinic know as soon as possible.

We continue to test staff members weekly. Exposure and risk for our team members and residents is rising. Please continue to socially distance yourself from others, wear masks and wash hands properly.
