



## CAMPUS UPDATE - November 6, 2020

All visitation for residents of the Drinkard Healthcare Center and the Rehab Center on 6<sup>th</sup> floor Hearthside remains suspended for at least another 7 days due to the positive test result identified last week. This is a timeline required by Medicare. There were no positive test results among residents in the Drinkard Center after testing conducted on Nov. 2.

No new cases of the coronavirus, for either residents or employees, were identified during this past week. Team members working in care areas will go through another cycle of COVID-19 virus testing beginning Sunday (Nov. 8) and concluding on Tuesday, Nov. 10.

Family visits for Assisted Living and Memory Support residents continue by appointment.

Apartment and cottage residents have the opportunity to have family members, two at a time please, visit outdoors daily, 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. We do ask that you contact the Resident Life and Wellness Office, Extension 3515 or 3516, to schedule these visits. Or you may use the “Schedule Family Visit” link on our public website ([www.wclynchburg.org](http://www.wclynchburg.org)) or the internal Resident website. Appointments help us plan the appropriate staff levels for screening in the main lobby when people arrive.

Team members for Senior Independence, our home health and hospice agency, continue to serve clients. Those agency employees who tested positive for the coronavirus in the past two weeks are doing well.

Please continue to wear facemasks, wash your hands often and practice social distancing in all public areas on and off campus. Thank you for your continued patience and understanding. We appreciate your support.
