



CAMPUS UPDATE – December 17, 2020

We need to report that we received a new positive result after COVID-19 testing conducted for our team members earlier in the week. An employee assigned to the 6th floor neighborhood of Drinkard Healthcare is the most recent positive result. This team member last worked the evening of December 13.

We have also identified today a resident of our Memory Support neighborhood as positive for the virus. This person is being assessed at Lynchburg General Hospital currently.

Visitation in all care areas, Assisted Living, Drinkard Healthcare, Memory Support and the 6th floor of Hearthside, remains suspended until further notice. Families are permitted to visit those residents receiving end of life care.

As we noted in yesterday's message, families may schedule a virtual visit for Christmas Day. 10-minute, FaceTime calls are available on a first-come-first-serve basis. We will try to accommodate as many people as possible. Time slots will begin at 9:00 a.m. and will go until 4:30 p.m. Please contact the Activities Staff Members to schedule.

COVID Vaccine Information

We have partnered with Walgreens/PharMerica to begin the vaccination process when doses become available for us. Ashley Jorden, RN, our infection control nurse, has provided Walgreens with the information they have requested so far regarding the number of employees and the number of residents on our campus.

Residents are asked to complete a consent form before the vaccine is administered. Team members serving in our care areas will facilitate this process for residents. Apartment and cottage residents will receive the consent form and instructions through in-house mail. Our goal is to distribute this information tomorrow, Friday, Dec. 18.
