



CAMPUS UPDATE – December 19, 2020

We need to report that we received a new positive COVID-19 test result for a team member today. This individual works on the 6th floor of Drinkard Healthcare and was last at work on Thursday, December 17. This person wore the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and followed proper infection control procedures while working.

All residents in our Healthcare and Assisted Living neighborhoods were tested for COVID-19 on Thursday, Dec. 17. There are no positive results for residents at this time.

As we have done in the past, we will notify anyone who we have reason to believe may have come in contact with an infected person. Ashley Jordan, RN and Infection Preventionist, leads our contact tracing protocol. She is supported by LPNs Lenee Shay and Tracey Goff of our Resident Clinic. We continue to report and work with the Department of Health on each case.

Testing for team members and residents continues next week on Tuesday, Dec. 22 and again on Thursday, Dec. 24. This schedule is required because the positivity rate for new cases of COVID-19 is over 15 percent in the Central Virginia Health District. This means that Westminster Canterbury remains in a state of anticipating potential positive test results daily.

Visitation in all care areas, Assisted Living, Drinkard Healthcare, Memory Support and the 6th floor of Hearthside, remains suspended until further notice. Families are permitted to visit those residents receiving end of life care.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to work through this difficult time.
