Our recent cycle of testing for staff members this week (Dec. 1) produced one new positive result for COVID-19. This team member last worked this Tuesday on the 6th floor of the Drinkard Healthcare Center. We have notified residents and/or families that had contact with this individual.

Visitation for Drinkard residents remains suspended until further notice. COVID-19 testing for all residents of the healthcare center will be done tomorrow, Friday, Dec. 4.

We are optimistic that visitation for Assisted Living and Memory Support residents may resume next week. Families will be notified if we are able to schedule appointments.

The 4th floor Drinkard resident who had a positive result for the virus this week is hospitalized and is in stable condition at this point in time.

Cases of the virus among the general public continue to rise in our health district.

Please continue following our safety guidelines on campus and wherever you go:

1. Wear your facemask in all public spaces.
2. Only 2 people at one time in the elevator with masks on.
3. Practice social distancing with everyone you encounter, staying at least 6 feet apart.
