



CAMPUS UPDATE – December 9, 2020

We learned today that three staff members have tested positive for COVID-19. One individual is a member of Dining Services who last worked in the Wood Dining Room of Assisted Living a week ago. This person did not show symptoms until yesterday. We are advised that there is no concern for exposure to co-workers or residents because of the time from the last day of work to the first sign of symptoms.

The other two team members who are positive for the virus work in the Memory Support Center. All residents in this neighborhood were tested this morning and all results are negative.

Visitation in all care areas, Assisted Living, Drinkard Healthcare, Memory Support and the 6th floor of Hearthside, remains suspended until further notice. Families are permitted to visit those residents receiving end of life care.

The next cycle of testing for all employees will be done tomorrow, Thursday, Dec. 10.

Cases of the virus among the general public continue to rise in our health district. We are now over the 11% positivity mark and must test our team members twice a week.

This level of testing will continue until the positivity rate drops below 10 percent. Please continue to follow all our safety protocols.
