



## **CAMPUS UPDATE – July 10, 2020**

### **COVID-19 BASELINE TESTING**

Westminster Canterbury of Lynchburg completed baseline testing for the COVID-19 virus on July 7. A unit of the Virginia National Guard came to campus and administered the test to residents of our assisted living and healthcare neighborhoods, and all employees. More than 560 people were tested. Individuals will be notified if their results are positive and the website will be updated.

Baseline testing is required under Phase 1 of the guidelines set forth by Virginia Gov. Northam for the safe opening of healthcare facilities in the State. A second round of tests is scheduled for the week of July 13.

The Virginia Department of Health sent results today for half the group tested on July 7. From the results received, there are no positive results for residents. Unfortunately, there is one positive test result for an employee.

This staff member worked on the 4<sup>th</sup> Floor of the Drinkard Healthcare Building. The employee has been asymptomatic and wore personal protective equipment while working. The employee is being retested today to rule-out the original result as a false positive.

Visitor restrictions remain in place.
