We received word this morning that the resident in the Memory Support area who tested positive for the COVID-19 virus on Sunday, has a negative test result after being retested. We have concluded that the second positive test produced a false positive result. The individual has returned to the Memory Support neighborhood after being quarantined.

All other residents and staff members in Memory Support have negative results from the first and second rounds of testing.

As of today, we have finished two cycles of testing for all employees and residents in our healthcare, assisted living and memory support neighborhoods. There are no positive test results for residents at this time. There are no positive results among residents in independent living as well.

There are no new reports of staff member infections over the past two days.

We will test residents in healthcare, assisted living and memory support next Tuesday, July 28. All employees will be tested as well.
