

## CAMPUS UPDATE - 8/9/2021

### All Visitation to Assisted Living and Memory Support neighborhoods is Suspended until Further Notice.

A positive COVID-19 test result was received over the weekend for a member of our team. This individual last worked on August 7 in our assisted living areas. All assisted living and memory support neighborhoods on our campus were closed to visitors this morning (Monday, August 9) as we performed testing for team members and residents. The test results for these residents are all negative.

Testing for residents will be conducted on Monday over the next two weeks. Staff members will be tested twice weekly.

Group activities in assisted living have been suspended. FaceTime visits may be scheduled through the Therapeutic Recreation team; but, these must be limited to 5 minutes per visit in order to limit exposure time between residents and team members.

Activities in our memory support neighborhood will continue following social distancing protocols.

#### **6<sup>th</sup> floor Rehab Center Closed to Visitors**


Residents and team members are following COVID-19 protocols in our short-term rehabilitation section due to an exposure and a pending COVID test result for a staff member.

Temperature screening and masks are required.*

**IN ADDITION:** We have a COVID-positive resident in independent living. This person received a positive test result over the weekend. Through our contact tracing, we believe there are no further exposures to other residents at this time. This resident is following our isolation procedures.

Our Infection Control Team completed the necessary contact tracing for these situations and has consulted with the State Health Department.
