



CAMPUS UPDATE - August 13, 2020

Westminster Canterbury of Lynchburg learned today that one of our staff members tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. This team member did not work in a healthcare area and was not in a position working directly with or around any of our residents. The employee used personal protective equipment appropriately while working, and was last on campus on Thursday, August 6.

The staff member was not feeling well and went to a physician on their own. This case was not identified in our fourth round of testing conducted on August 10. This is the 11th employee to test positive since the beginning of July.

Many of you have expressed concern for our employees and asked about their recoveries. We have one person in the hospital currently. There are five people quarantined in their homes with symptoms of COVID-19 and five team members have recovered fully and are back at work.
