



## **CAMPUS UPDATE - August 21, 2020**

We have not had any positive COVID-19 test results for residents or staff members this week. We will conduct Round 5 of testing on Tuesday, August 25.

### **Health Care Status**

Our Round 4 of testing was considered “clean”- no new COVID-19 positive cases identified in testing for residents or team members. However, as we shared in previous communications, several employees tested positive on their own (meaning they had symptoms and were tested by their doctor) between our rounds of testing. We learned from the State of Virginia that we are still in Phase 1 for our Health Care path and still need two “clean” test cycles to move into Phase 2.

No visitors are allowed at this time except for end of life and compassionate care situations.

### **Assisted Living and Memory Support Status**

Beginning Monday, August 24 we will begin limited visitation for our residents and their immediate family members in Assisted Living and Memory Support. Team members are calling families to schedule visits.

**Please know that all visitation to our campus requires screenings and temperature checks upon arrival.** Staff members will provide instruction as visits are scheduled.

We recently learned that we don't need to perform another cycle of testing for people in these two neighborhoods. Therefore, these residents will not be tested next week. We will test if residents develop signs or symptoms for COVID-19, or if we identify a certain number of staff members that test positive in a particular area.

### **Independent Living**

No visitors allowed at this point in time. Our Reopening Committee (comprised of residents, board members and staff) is working on a plan for future visitation and timelines. We will share details when available.


