



## **CAMPUS UPDATE - September 11, 2020**

Westminster Canterbury learned today that one of our staff members tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. This person last worked September 9 on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the Drinkard Healthcare Center. Due to the employee's appropriate use of personal protective equipment while working, we are not going to quarantine any residents at this time.

We have tested 12 residents on the floor that had contact with the staff member using our new antigen testing machine. The residents all had negative results. These 12 residents will be retested on Tuesday as part of our new protocol.

This positive result was identified in Round 8 of our testing cycle. There are no other positives in this round of tests. Round 9 testing began today. These two test cycles were for employees only per state and federal protocols.

We continue to work with the local health department to ensure we are taking all proper precautions.
